

STUDIO ART SCHOLARSHIPS

Virgil M. Beall Fellowship

Eligibility: Graduate student

Awards: One studio fellowship with \$8000 stipend paid over the academic year. Recipient receives in-state resident tuition rate.

Wilhelm and Jane Bodine Fellowship

Eligibility: Graduate student

Awards: Two studio fellowships with \$8200 stipend paid over the academic year. Recipient receives in-state resident tuition rate.

Iowa Arts Fellowship

Two-year fellowship, renewable in the second year contingent upon demonstrated exceptional progress toward completion of the MFA degree.

Eligibility: Incoming or current graduate student in MFA program; 3.0 minimum GPA;

Awards: Two studio awards with \$15,000 paid over academic year, plus tuition is paid. Additional names can be put forward to be considered for the five additional competitive awards the Grad College considers among other arts areas.

W.T. Proudfoot Scholarship

Eligibility: Undergraduate or graduate Student; preference to Warren County (Warren county includes Ackworth, *Bevington, *Carlisle, Cumming, *Des Moines, Hartford, Indianola, Lacona, Martensdale, Milo, New Virginia, *Norwalk, Sandyville, Spring Hill, St Marys and *West Des Moines--*asterisk indicates city has portions in an adjacent county or counties)

Awards: Award one \$1000 scholarship to be paid in two \$500 lump sums at beginning of each semester. Students graduating December 2009 may receive entire scholarship in fall semester.

Lucinda Mendenhalle Wilde Scholarship

Eligibility: Upper-class undergraduate or graduate Student. Award is to help deserving students in art.

Awards: Award two \$850 awards in 09-10 to be paid in two \$425 installments at the beginning of each semester. Students graduating December 2009 may receive entire scholarship in fall semester.

Iowa Center for the Arts Scholarship

Eligibility: Incoming freshman or upper-class undergraduate student; 3.0 GPA

Awards: \$26,000 is to be divided into awards for students. Amount and number of awards can vary.

Mary Sue Miller Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility: To fund an annual scholarship to an undergraduate student majoring in art. Award based primarily on academic record and financial need. Students from Fremont County, IA, are to be given preference (Fremont county includes cities of Anderson, Bartlett, Farragut, Hamburg, Imogene, McPaul, Payne, Percival, Randolph, Riverton, Sidney, Summit, Tabor, Thurman). Incoming freshmen are eligible. Scholarship is renewable for additional years of undergraduate work, provided the recipient makes suitable academic progress. SAAH selects the most logical candidates, names and qualifications are transmitted to donor for consideration prior to selection of winner. Process includes approval of portfolio by Ms. Miller

Awards: Award four \$1500 scholarships to be paid in two lump sums of \$750 each semester. Try to have four recipients each year, including those continuing.

Emma McAllister Novel Scholarship

Eligibility: Upper-class undergraduate or graduate student; African-American; based on merit. This fund provides an annual 1500 scholarship to a minority student in the School. The award recipient is chosen on basis of need and excellence, with no preference toward undergraduate or graduate resident or nonresident students.

Howard & Ruth Schumacher Scholarship

Eligibility: Undergraduate majors who demonstrate exceptional artistic or scholarly talent.

Awards: \$1700 in funding can be awarded in varying amounts to one or more students. Proposals on use of funds submitted to director.

Orton and Eugenia Hamby Scholarship

Eligibility: Undergraduate or graduate student
