2012 Women's History Month Bookmark Contest

## Rules

- Entrants must be a student in grades K-6 in Johnson County, Iowa. Home schooled students at the same grade level may also enter. Each student may only submit one entry.
- Entries must be submitted on paper by mail and postmarked no later than March 1. No electronic submissions will be accepted.
- The children of Council on the Status of Women or Herstory members are not eligible.
- To be considered, complete entries must include a title and/or caption, and a completed cover sheet with a signature indicating that the entrant is the sole creator of the bookmark.
- Bookmarks absolutely must not contain copyrighted work owned by a third party without their written permission. Artwork must be entirely that of the person named on the bookmark.
- Bookmarks must represent an aspect of Women's History.

## Evaluation

Bookmarks will be evaluated on creativity and relevance to Women's History Month by a panel appointed by the Herstory Committee of the UI Council on the Status of Women.
