Norman Hansen, an attorney in Des Moines, recommended that you may be able to help our organization in connection with ongoing air pollution from the Iowa Lumber Company (ILCO) waferboard plant in Clinton, Iowa. We have been concerned about this for some time, and have now obtained copies of the company's air pollution permit along with operating reports going back to 1993.

The Iowa Clean Air Coalition (ICAC) is a not-for-profit membership corporation organized under the laws of the State of Iowa, with offices in Des Moines, Iowa. ICAC is dedicated to the defense of the environment, wildlife, and natural resources, by preserving and protecting air quality. We have over 1,000 Iowa resident members, including at least twenty who reside in or near Clinton and many more who breathe, enjoy, and benefit from the clean air that characterizes the National Ambient Air Quality attainment area surrounding the Iowa Lumber Company facility.

Is there anything we can do about this? We can't believe that ILCO was able to get a permit for this massive facility without obtaining a federal permit under the Clean Air Act! We will be happy to send you the documents if you are willing to look into the matter. Thanks for any help that you can provide.
