Who is eligible to be in the volunteer research registry?

Anyone age 50 or over can enroll in the STAR Registry. People with medical problems, as well as healthy people, are invited to participate.



Why be a Volunteer in the STAR Registry?

- ★ Learn about the research process
- ★ Receive information about healthy aging and University of Iowa research studies for adults
- ★ Many studies provide compensation

What types of research studies will be offered to persons in the registry?

- ★ Take a survey
- ★ Participate in a clinical trial
- ★ Share your opinions

Participation in any research study and the STAR Registry is voluntary. You may decide to leave the study or registry at any time.
