## INVITATION TO APPLY

The UICB invites applications for the Center for the Book Graduate Fellowship. These awards will be given for the academic year 2007-08 and will entail a stipend of money paid monthly and will also permit recipients to pay in-state tuition. Applicants should be graduate students enrolled in good standing in the Center's certificate program.

Applicants should submit:

- 1) a brief letter of application, describing and evaluating your progress so far and discussing your goals for the coming year.
- 2) a listing of any employment or financial support received through the University.
- 3) a portfolio of recent work (5-10 actual objects or digital images).
- 4) if you are a new admit for Fall 2007, your admission applications will be used for review. Please send, however, a brief letter of intent, discussing your goals for the coming year.

Please submit these materials to the UICB Graduate Fellowship Committee, c/o Matthew P. Brown, 308 EPB.

Criteria for selection will be based on merit and need, with preference given to students focusing on the arts and technologies and to students lacking other means of institutional support. For 2007-08, there will be up to two or three awards given, in either full-year or half-year allotments.
