Committee Charge:

- Advise on the establishment of general policies for the orderly, efficient and attractive development of the University's physical campus and facilities, giving particular attention to aesthetic and ecological considerations;
- Advise on proposals for major development or building projects and proposals for major revisions in ongoing projects, giving consideration to compatibility with existing standards and policies and site selection;
- Advise on policies of space allocation and utilization, major modification or reallocations of existing facilities and the response to development proposals of all affected elements of the University.

Activities:

- Review and development of campus environment policies including wayfinding and signage
- Review of long-term campus development plans including those for future UIHC expansion
- Active ongoing review and development of numerous projects large and small including
 - Orthopedics and Sports Medicine Clinic Building
 - Institute for Biomedical Discovery Building
 - Oakdale Bioventures Building
 - Carver Hawkeye Arena addition
 - Environmental Management Facility
