1. CLAY: wheel thrown, coil, slab, modeled.
2. FIBER: macramé, weaving, knitting, crocheting, basketry, batik, books.
3. GLASS: stained, etched, beveled, blown, mirrors.
4. METALS: metal sculpture.
5. JEWELRY: glass, metal, wood, bead, stone, fiber.
6. MIXED MEDIA: any pieces combining two or more media, i.e. wood and glass, clay and metal
7. NEEDLEWORK: quilting, soft sculpture, sewn toys, clothing, patchwork, appliqué.
8. PAINTING/DRAWING: traditional painting and drawing media; also collage, glass painting, decorative painting.
9. PRINTMAKING: monotypes, silk-screen, woodcuts, intaglio, lithography, embossed paper.
10. PHOTOGRAPHY
11. WOOD: wooden toys, sculpture, furniture, musical instruments.
12. OTHER: calligraphy, leather, lapidary, candles, miniatures, etc.

The Riverbank Art Fair

The University of Iowa Riverbank Art Fair will be held south of Hancher Green on the Canoe House Lawn on the University of Iowa campus, west of the Iowa River accessible from Riverside Drive. This is an outdoor location, in a beautiful setting with lots of free parking, and within easy access of artist setup. The Riverbank Art Fair is held in conjunction with the University sponsored Riverfest, an annual spring celebration featuring a variety of musical performances, ethnic foods, RiverRun, and much more.

Application process: The art fair is juried and open to all artists and craftspeople. The jury fee is \$10.00 per medium. **No** kits, molded items, commercially formed items (including commercially printed matter), antiques, plants or imports are allowed. Limited edition prints of #1000 are acceptable. Items to be sold **cannot** include commercial designs (Precious Moments motifs, college logos, etc.). **ANY ARTIST WHOSE WORK IS FOUND TO BE UNORIGINAL OR TO BE INCONSISTENT WITH THEIR SUBMITTED SLIDES WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE THE MARKET.**

Application deadline: APPLICATIONS ARE DUE MARCH 1st. The FAC will NOT accept any late applications. Artists accepted through the jury process will receive an acceptance notice on which they will indicate whether or not they plan to exhibit in the market. This letter will also contain a map and visitor information. Exhibitor booth fees should not be paid until notification of acceptance is received.

Please submit the following when applying:

1. The above Application Form
2. \$10.00 Jury fee per medium. Make check payable to the U of I Fine Arts Council
3. One SELF-ADDRESSED, LEGAL SIZED, STAMPED ENVELOPE
4. Exactly three slides or photo prints per medium that are labeled with NAME, CATEGORY and TOP. The Fine Arts Council will make every effort to safeguard your slides/prints, but will not assume responsibility for lost or damaged materials.
5. All entries **must be** received by the application deadline designated by the FAC.

Exhibitor booth fees: (To be paid only upon acceptance) U of I students: \$55, other artists: \$125.

Display: Artists are responsible for set-ups that are suitable for outdoors. Tables and chairs will **not** be provided. Setup begins at 6:00 a.m. and must be completed by 9:30 a.m. All artists must check in at the registration table by 8:30 a.m. before setting up. 10' x 10' spaces will be assigned. If you need more space for demonstration purposes, please let us know. The Riverbank Art Fair will be held rain or shine, please plan accordingly.
