

Terms and Conditions for Inclusive Rates

Currency:	Qatar - QR (Qatari Riyal). Other currencies accepted by Qatar are as follows: EUR, USD, GBP and UAE Dirham
Sales Tax:	Not Applicable.
Airport Tax:	QR 5 per rental.
Mileage:	Limited Mileage of 150 KM per day. Additional KM are charged QR 0.77 -2.30 depending on car group.
Road Fund/Licence Fee:	Not applicable.
Additional Driver:	A maximum of one additional driver is permitted at a surcharge of 12% of the net rental cost.
Driver requirements:	21 to 24 year olds are permitted to drive the ECMR & CCMR vehicles and are classed as young drivers. 25 - 29 year olds are permitted to drive all cars except 4-wheel drives (SFAR & FFAR) any sports or luxury vehicles - drivers must be at least 30 years of age for these categories. Maximum driving age is 65 years. Licenses must be a photo i.d. licence and be free of all endorsements and penalties. In addition an international drivers permit is required. International driving permits are accepted at the locations discretion. The rental location will retain photocopies of all driving licences and passports.
Young Driver Surcharge:	Young drivers surcharge is calculated at 25% of daily rental rate.
Payment Policy:	All major credit cards are accepted: Diners, American Express, Visa, Eurocard and Master Card. Vouchers are accepted. No cash payments accepted. National charge cards, Travellers cheques and Eurocheques are not acceptable.
Domestic One Way:	Vehicles can be returned to any location in Doha City, including the Airport, at no charge provided that the rental is for at least 2 days. Only the following vehicles are permitted for one-ways: CCMR, CDMR, and SDAR. One-ways do not have to be pre booked.
Refuelling:	The vehicle is supplied with a full tank of fuel. Return full or refuelling charges will apply at the prevailing pump price as determined by National. A surcharge of 10% of the cost of the missing fuel will apply in addition to the refuelling charge.
Delivery and Collection:	During office hours: free of charge within 5 KM of the National location. Between 5 KM and 10 KM charged at QAR 2 per KM. Over 10 KM charged at QAR 5 per KM.
Out of Hours:	Outside office hours: Delivery/Collection point must be 10 KM or less - charged at QAR 5 per KM.
Cross Border Policy:	It is not permitted to cross the Qatari border.
Third Party Liability:¹ Primary	Maximum liability for third parties: Unlimited cover for death, disability, and property Required by laws of country and included in all rates.
CDW, mandatory:	Collision Damage Waiver is mandatory and is included in the rental rate. Deductible QR 2,000 to QR 8,000 depending on car group.
TP, mandatory:	Theft protection is mandatory and is included in the rental rate.
PAI & PEC, optional:	Personal Accident Insurance is not available to purchase but free Government health and medical services are provided to all in Qatar. Personal Effect Coverage. If purchased, allows for the reimbursement concerning the loss/damage of personal effects. Conditions are dependent on circumstances - QR 15 per day.
SCDW, optional:	SCDW includes all the benefits of normal CDW but additionally covers the theft of the vehicle and reduces the deductible to between QR 500 and QR 2,000 depending on the class of vehicle rented. QR 12.50 - 37.50 per day depending on car group.
Special Equipment:	Infant Seat (CSI) QR 15 per day to a maximum of QR 100 per rental. Child Seat (CST) QR 15 per day to a maximum of QR 100 per rental. All Special Equipment is on request only and 72 hours advance notice is required. Deposit required is QR 100. Not available for one ways. Seat belts are compulsory for all passengers. No child under the age of 12 years is permitted to travel in the front seats of the vehicle.
Roadside Assistance:	In case of breakdown or accident telephone the 24 hour Emergency number that is quoted on the rental agreement or located within the rental vehicle. Accidents must be reported to the police immediately to ensure that a Police Report can be obtained at the scene of the accident. Renters should also call the National Car Rental Emergency number in order that they may assist at the accident scene. Failure to implement the above infringes Qatar's legal system. A replacement car will be provided if necessary.
