Program Description: The two to twelve week program is designed to provide flexible, customized instruction in the areas of drug information and informatics for practicing pharmacists. Each instructional section is tailored to meet the needs of the individual. Program faculty will consult with the pharmacist to assess his or her current knowledge and skill level and establish the educational goals for the program. Program content is delivered through a combination of lectures, readings, discussions, assignments, participation in ongoing projects, verbal and written presentations, and experiential training.

Program Fees and Arrangements: Instructional fees vary depending on the length of the program. Visit our website for complete cost information. The individual trainee is responsible for applicable U.S. and home travel/visit authorization and documents, travel/medical/life insurance, transportation, housing and meals during the training period. The Division can arrange local housing and transportation. The World Health Organization (WHO) has funded fellowships in the past for this training.
