The Division of Drug Information Service offers a retrieval and evaluation service for healthcare providers, medical-legal workers, and insurance benefit organizations. We can address specific needs for detailed information about an individual medication, a group of medications, drug therapy for treatment or prevention of a specific disease, or other questions about the therapeutic or clinical pharmaceutical use of medications.

Service is customized and may include all or some of the following:

- consultation to determine and clearly define the specific information need,
- a search of the appropriate drug and medical literature databases to find the best available evidence to address the information need,
- retrieval of the appropriate documents,
- evaluation of the evidence, and
- a synthesis to provide an evidence-based report and conclusion.

Pharmacists with advanced training and experience in literature retrieval and evaluation provide the service.

Inquiries: Upon inquiry, a pharmacist will spend up to one-half hour with the requester to determine their information need. A written quotation of the service to be provided and the associated fees will be provided.
