

Instruction for the Integrative Activity:

Person A:

You are the young rock star who is going to be interviewed. Look at your “ID” card, and answer the questions in Nihongo an interviewer asks you.

Person B:

You are the interviewer from a famous TV company. Today a famous young rock star is in town, so you are going to interview the person. You have the list of the questions you need to ask for your show. Look at the list, and ask questions in Nihongo.

Person C:

You are the journalist. Today you are going to hear the interview of a young rock star, held in a TV company. You have the information sheet to fill in as you listen to the interview. Listen carefully and fill the information sheet in Nihongo.

Instruction:

- Sit in circles.
- Person B (the interviewer), start asking questions to person A (the rock star).
- Person A, answer the questions.
- Person C (the journalist), listen to their interview and fill in the note.

(Person B)

Questions to ask:

- the person's name
- where the person is from.
- if the person is a student (if so, ask what year the person is in).
- if the person's friend is Ono Yoko
- if the person's language is English

Instruction for the Oral Exam:

Topic: Self-introduction

- Include:
- greeting (beginning and ending)
 - your name
 - your nationality
 - where you are from (country)
 - your language
 - your status
 - year in school

*You may also include some other things (gender, about your friend, teacher, etc) that we covered in the class.
