Approximately once a month on a Saturday Night the group hosts Night Games at the UI Field House from 9 p.m. to 1 a.m. Activities such as basketball, badminton, rock climbing, swimming, volleyball, dodgeball, and special events are free and open to the public. Night Games is coordinated by University Housing/Office of Residence Life and Recreation Services.

Eligibility

The Night Games Executive Council is responsible for planning and implementing all aspects of the event. A Council member's term is one year and may be renewed for the following academic year. It is expected that Executive Council members will attend monthly meetings and all Night Games unless prior permission is granted by the President or the Advisor. Members must actively contribute to each Night Games event. A members' role for each event will be determined at the monthly Night Games Council meetings, which are mandatory.
