The Old Capitol Museum is open from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday; 10:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Thursday and Saturday; 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. on Sunday. The museum is closed on Mondays and national holidays.

ATTENTION: TEACHERS

When you arrive, you will be met at the east entrance by the receptionist. Guides will be on hand to give you a tour. Many of the guides are volunteers who contribute their time so that you and others may see and learn about Old Capitol.

A ramp entrance (south ground floor entrance), and elevator (hold 1 standard wheelchair only), and a wheelchair are available for persons who are unable to use the stairs. Please ring the bell or knock at the ramp entrance.

Regulations Governing Tours of Old Capitol

In order that you and other visitors to Old Capitol may truly enjoy visiting the museum, please note and follow the following regulations:

*Elementary, junior high, and high school groups are required to have at least one adult for every 12 students in order to maintain quiet and general good conduct. Admittance may be denied to groups which do not meet this requirement.

*Please stay in front of the barriers, which control the flow of traffic in the rooms.

*Keep the members of your group together while touring the building.

*Smoking is prohibited, and food and beverages are not allowed.

****Groups arriving later than their scheduled time risk not seeing the building since it may not be possible to reschedule the tour. Groups arriving earlier than expected may be asked to wait until their scheduled time.**
