

Minutes from UISC Members Meeting on Saturday, 7/1/06 in the Social Center of the ISC boathouse.

The meeting was called to order at 4:19 p.m. by Commodore Ben Miller-Todd.

- I. The minutes from the previous Member's meeting are currently stuck in Ben's email account and will be send out on the list serve at a later time.
- II. Officer Reports:
  - A. Matt Legg, membership and social chairs:
    - i. We have a lot of new members this summer, but very few renewals. Matt has contacted all members whose membership expired on May 1<sup>st</sup>, but only four of the 40 contacted have renewed.
  - B. Rich Adkins, fleet captain:
    - i. The C scow was sold for \$770 and has been picked up.
    - ii. Two unregistered windsurfers without rigging were sold for \$250 (total).
    - iii. The M16 and Penguin should be listed on eBay and the pictures of the E scow will be put up on eBay soon.
    - iv. We can not sell the old wooden Penguin because the owner has not signed it over to us, but we may be able to use if for ground school.
  - C. Matt Legg, team captain:
    - i. The person we originally wanted to coach the team sailing camp is unable to teach the weekend we planned on.
    - ii. Hopefully we will be able to find someone else interested in teaching the camp soon. Matt will contact Mark Johnson and Jeff Moses and hopefully have someone by the end of the week. US sailing may be able to recommend someone.
  - D. Daniel Rogge, rear commodore:
    - i. He would like to have a Hobie regatta. It would possibly be on July 15<sup>th</sup>.
- III. Old Business:
  - A. The teaching days have all been completed and were successful.
  - B. An email account was set up to RSVP for Bastille Day. The email address is [rsvp@iowasailing.org](mailto:rsvp@iowasailing.org). The calendar was also updated to show the changed date for Bastille Day (July 22<sup>nd</sup>). The party for Bastille Day is at Steve and Jayne's. We still need to figure out food, but may be able to grill out and buy sides instead of catering the event. Warren is taking care of drinks.
  - C. One of the 420s is repaired and ready for pickup from the Columbia Yacht Club. The other will be ready in late July and we can pick them up together. We need to pay for them when we pick them up.

- IV. New Business:
- A. No notice of race was sent out for the races today. That should be done in the week before the race.
  - B. Club members should try to network as much as possible and let others know when they plan on going to the boathouse so member's without keys can sail as well. Invite new members out for "unofficial" sailing as well.
  - C. Amy will send out a notice via the list serve for the parade of boats tomorrow.
  - D. An updated email list may be put up on the website so it can be easily copied and pasted to send emails to the entire club. There is a list currently available in the executive section of the website, but it is not comma separated.
  - E. Club members have been invited to race MCs at the North arm every Saturday with the Lake McBride Sailing Club. If there is enough interest, club members could tow boats over with our own crash boat. In the future we may invite Lake McBride Sailing Club members for races on our arm.
- V. Announcements:
- A. Tomorrow is the Parade of Boats. Meet at the boathouse at 11:00 a.m. to join in the sail to the North arm. We will put lunches in a cooler on the pontoon boat. The sail is 45 minutes to 1 hr 15 minutes each way. There is a 50% chance of thunderstorms, so check the radar before you come.
  - B. Matt found a backup albatross since the current one has been missing.
  - C. The albatross is in Ben's car and will be given to the Albatross winner at the end of the meeting.
  - D. Albatross nominations:
    - i. Mark Gleaves nominated himself before the meeting (he unfortunately could not stay) because he owes the club a new clipboard. He was race committee for today's races, but he does not know who won because he dropped the club's clipboard with the race results overboard on the way in.
    - ii. Matt Legg nominated Mark Gleaves for nominating himself before the meeting.
    - iii. Rich Adkins nominated Erin Wehr-Flowers and himself for almost pushing off this morning without some important equipment. Rich and Erin had rigged their boat and also shoved off the dock before they realized they had neither a rudder nor a tiller. Rich had to run up the hill to get them.
