Directions to Currier Hall:

From Route 80 Eastbound: Take exit 244. Turn right onto Dubuque Street.

From Route 80 Westbound: Take exit 244. Turn left onto Dubuque Street.

Follow Dubuque Street down the hill, through a stop light, and up a steep hill.

At the top of the hill, turn right at the stop light on to Church Street.

Church Street curves around into Clinton Street. Currier Hall will be the first big brick building on the right off of Clinton Street.

Parking:

You may choose to try to find a spot on the street (two-hour meters @ 75¢/hour or for free in the residential neighborhood — just pay attention to the parking signs).

North Ramp (lot 20) is another option which is located behind Currier Hall. Follow Clinton Street past Currier Hall to the stop light. Turn right onto Market Street and follow to the bottom of the hill. Turn right onto Madison Street and follow for two blocks. Turn right — North Ramp is at the top of the hill. Parking for up to four hours is \$3.45.
