





Understanding the TV Rating System and What is Typically Shown on UITV

	<p>General Audience Most parents would find this program suitable for all ages. Although this rating does not signify a program designed specifically for children, most parents may let younger children watch this program unattended. It contains little or no violence, no strong language and little or no sexual dialogue or situations.</p> <p style="color: red;">This is the most common type of program seen on UITV, and everything broadcast from 5:30 AM to 6:30 PM</p>
	<p>Parental Guidance Suggested This program contains material that parents may find unsuitable for younger children. Many parents may want to watch it with their younger children. The theme itself may call for parental guidance and/or the program contains one or more of the following: moderate violence (V), some sexual situations (S), infrequent coarse language (L), or some suggestive dialogue (D).</p> <p style="color: red;">Many of our lectures fall into this category. Professors speak frankly about a topic, and may show more mature images. Most SVP programming falls into this category. These programs are shown after 6:30 PM.</p>
	<p>Parents Strongly Cautioned This program contains some material that many parents would find unsuitable for children under 14 years of age. Parents are strongly urged to exercise greater care in monitoring this program and are cautioned against letting children under the age of 14 watch unattended. This program contains one or more of the following: intense violence (V), intense sexual situations (S), strong coarse language (L), or intensely suggestive dialogue (D).</p> <p style="color: red;">Programs that are TV-14 are never shown before 8:00 PM, and are more typically shown after 10:00 PM. These programs always carry a disclaimer to notify the audience that the content is more intense.</p>
	<p>Mature Audience Only This program is specifically designed to be viewed by adults and therefore may be unsuitable for children under 17. This program contains one or more of the following: graphic violence (V), explicit sexual activity (S), or crude indecent language (L).</p> <p style="color: red;">Because UITV is a “PEG” (Public-Education-Government) channel on the basic tier cable, it is never appropriate to show TV-MA programming. Programs that are TV-MA will need to be edited to fit a TV-14 designation before broadcast.</p>
