Program

The NSF VIGRE-Heartland REU offers students a taste of life and work as a graduate student at a research university. The program includes a short course and small group research projects, as well as social/cultural activities.

All aspects of our program will be run in close cooperation with the NSF Alliance program. Students will have the opportunity to share mathematics and share community with ethnically diverse students from around the country.

Stipend

Students will receive a stipend of \$3,200 (which includes a stipend for breakfast and lunch) as well as room and a dinner contract on campus. All reasonable travel expenses to and from Iowa City for the program will also be reimbursed.

Eligibility

While preference is given to students attending a Heartland Partnership School, any undergraduate student who is a U.S. Citizen or permanent resident may apply. The program is designed for highly motivated students who have completed their first two years of college. Younger or more advanced students will be considered.
