ADA JOHNSON/OTILIA MARIA FERNANDEZ SCHOLARSHIP

The Women's Studies Department invites **undergraduate** student applications for the Ada Johnson/Otilia Maria Fernandez Women's Studies Scholarship. Please bring this opportunity to the attention of your students.

In honor of Ada Johnson, one of the first black women students to graduate from The University of Iowa (1912) and Otilia Maria Fernandez, one of the first Hispanic woman graduates (1924), Women's Studies has established an annual scholarship of \$1000 for a woman student of color who has taken courses in the Women's Studies Department or whose academic interests include some aspect of women's culture or experience.

The 2009 Ada Johnson/Otilia Maria Fernandez Scholarship will be awarded to an **undergraduate** student. Awards will be presented on the basis of academic performance and commitment to issues relevant to women of color.

APPLICATION MATERIALS SHOULD INCLUDE:

- A. a cover page giving name, address, e-mail address, years of study at Iowa, and other forms of financial aid/work for the academic year 2008-2009;
- B. transcripts of all undergraduate work;
- C. a one-page statement describing your academic or career goals, and some ways in which these reflect a concern for women's lives; and
- D. two letters of recommendation.
